The need in the Food Bank's service area

- In the 34 counties served by the Food Bank of Central & Eastern North Carolina, 604,720 individuals live in food-insecure households
- 182,750 are children.
- 49,762 seniors live at or below the poverty level.

Fast facts

- In fiscal year 2017-2018, the Food Bank distributed **68,350,607** pounds of food, **60%** was perishable.

- The Food Bank distributed 26,023,980 pounds of fresh produce to our 34-county service area during fiscal year 2017-2018.
- The Food Bank partners with 928 partner agencies in our service area, including food pantries, shelters, soup kitchens and group homes.
- 230,694 volunteer hours
